Conditions of Play:

Singles, Pairs, Triples and Fours. (When hosted by Paritutu, then only Pairs, Triples and Fours will be played)

2 pts for a Win, 1 pt for a draw.

Overall Match Points, then Points Differential, then Points.

Jacks to be placed if incorrectly thrown

2 and a quarter hr Time Limit.

A killed end to be replayed. If killed after the bell then the jack will be spotted on the 2m Mark.

Player movement - Any 9 or 10 players can play in any of the 9 or 10 positions in any round. No limits on the use of substitutes.

Winners in the Men's and Winners in the Women's, if winners are split the Ron Buchan trophy will be awarded to the Centre with the most number of Match Points across both fixtures.

Singles: 21 shots

Pairs: 18 Ends.

Triples: 18 Ends.

Fours: 15 Ends.

Team Composition: 9 or 10 players (depending on venue).

Development sides to include players 8 Years and Under.

All games, whether conducted by a Club or the Centre, shall be played under and in strict conformity with the World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Fourth Edition, BNZ Domestic Regulations also apply.

Fixture Purpose: A competitive fixture to prepare our squads for representative fixtures later in the season, including the National Intercentre.
